1. Complete and return attached "Replacement of SRF Horse Into Program"
2. Send current Coggins and vaccination. Horse will not be accepted without a current Coggins test.
3. Remove shoes, required. Please have the hoofs trimmed and teeth checked, very helpful.
4. If you can keep your horse while we profile the horse to approved adopters it is
5. **Transport of the horse to an SRF facility is at your expense. (per your adoption contract)**
6. If you can obtain a few great photos of the horse it really makes a difference when profiling. The shot should show the front or side of the horse, showing the face of the horse. Horses tacked up to ride, with children and/or smiling riders really get a lot of attention. Please email a few to SRFAdoption@gmail.com.
7. SRF is 100% non-profit organization. If you can make a donation to help us with the expense of re-homing your horse it is much appreciated.
8. Once the attached form is complete, coggins and vaccine records received to SRF we will contact you with a return date, depending on in-take field availability.
